1. An Introduction of Shanker Dev Campus

Shanker Dev Campus (SDC) was founded in 1951 as Nepal National College which was housed temporarily at Durbar High School and then at Tri-Chandra College in Kathmandu. It came into existence as a Higher Educational Institution (HEI) as a result of the restructuring of the 1954's Commerce Department housed in Tri- Chandra College, the country's first Institution of Higher Education (IHOE). It was established in 2030 B.S. as a constituent campus of Tribhuvan University. The name of the college was changed in 1973 (2030 B.S) to Shanker Dev Campus following the government policy of amalgamating it into Tribhuvan University and recognizing Prof. Shanker Dev Pant's contributions, motivated primarily by his missionary zeal, towards purchasing a site and constructing a building for the college.

Shanker Dev Campus (SDC), a leading constituent Campus of Tribhuvan University (TU) is well known for its management education for the past many years, is probably the first choice of the students interested in management education in Nepal, mainly due to its commitment to provide quality education in various programs conducted for under graduates and gradates courses (Bachelors and Master's degree program) in Management. SDC offers wide range of management courses for various programs such as Master in Business Studies (MBS) and Master in Business Management (MBM) for Master degree and Bachelor of Business Studies (BBS), Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA), Bachelor of Information Management (BIM), Bachelor of Business Management (BBM) and Bachelor of Business Administration in Finance (BBA-Finance) for Bachelor degree program. Over the period SDC has been able to produce professional manpower in the field of management as well as it has also been able to produce politicians and administrators too. SDC is able to serve the nation by providing quality education in management as per the demand of 21st century to meet the opportunities and challenges of globalization. It carries the distinctive legacy as the Pioneer Campus in Management education in Nepal.

At present, the SDC is operating under the decentralized system and striving to be an autonomous institution to continue its present academic programs with the relevant market-driven courses to meet the growing demand in the country. SDC aims to provide excellent quality in education and produce competent managers, entrepreneurs and higher managerial manpower or human resources capable enough to work in an increasingly globalized society.

SDC also focuses to provide well- equipped well maintained and attractive services, facilities, and learning resources for the students.

2. Academic Faculties of Shanker Dev Campus

At present SDC has highly professional, competent and dedicated academic manpower to provide world class education in Management education. SDC has both Permanent (full time) and part time academic faculties. SDC has 42 full time and 88 part time academic faculties at present. Name of full time faculty has shown in table 1 and name of part time faculty has shown in table 2

2.1 Name list of full-time/permanent academic faculty of Shanker Dev Campus

SDC consists of highly professional and dedicated full-time faculties to run its programs; however, the number of full-time faculties is insufficient to meet the requirement of courses offered by SDC for the students. Due to the limited number of full time academic faculties in comparison to its number of students, SDC has more part-time academic faculties in comparison to full-time faculties to run the classes.

Among full-time faculties, professors (2) are very limited in number, associate professors are 10, lecturers are 27 and number of teaching assistance are 3. Among the M.Phil. holder academic faculties, most of them are PhD scholars.

6. Activities conducted by SDC throughout the Year 2076/2077

- 1. To enhance quality of education, Computer distribution program for teachers was conducted on 1st Shrawan 2076 with assistance of University Grand Commission
- 2. One day seminar on Management education in Shanker Dev Campus (past, Present and future) was conducted at Hotel Shangrilla at Lazimpat on 4th Shrawan 2076.
- 3. 66th commerce day was celebrated on 17th Bhadra, 2076. Various programs were conducted such as scholarship distribution, medal and prize distribution for merit students and Dirgha sewa padak distribution for teachers and administrative staffs who have offered serviced more than 20 years in SDC once at their lifetime.

- 4. On the special occasion of commerce day program, facilitation program to Mr. Arjun Bahadur Karki, secretary of Reconstruction Corporation of Nepal was conducted to recognize his outstanding contribution and support for construction project of academic building of SDC, which was destroyed due to earthquake 2072. Responsibility of Building construction is with Reconstruction Corporation, central project implementation unit (building) Babarmahal. Construction of Academic Building is work- in progress.
- 5. Career related program was conducted by former student society on the commerce day.
- 6. Throughout the year various case study program, workshop, training and seminars were conducted for the students of different program as per requirement.
- 7. Various educational tour programs within the country and India was conducted for different semester students as per their academic calendar as well as requirement.
- 8. SDC has started academic and administrative audit program for academic faculties and administrative faculties for 3 years starting from the academic year 2073/74, 2074/75 and 2075/76 to enhance quality of education and improve educational indicator used to measure the quality of education related to teaching and research related activities etc.
- 9. Due to the pandemic of covid-19, started from China and spread all over the world, all kind of activities across the world are affected. At the initial stage of pandemic, similar to other academic institutions, academic activities as well as administrative activities of SDC remain closed. Lingering the wait and watch situation, SDC started on line classes as per the instruction of TU. At the initial stage, on line classes were conducted through zoom meeting but later TU decided to provide training on Microsoft Team for online classes to university teachers. Zoom meeting classes are postponed and teachers trained for Microsoft team. After providing training and opening accounts of both teachers and students by TU, SDC resumed classes on Microsoft Team. Gradually other academic activities are also conducted through online. Thesis proposals are defended through online. Online classes are taken as opportunity to familiar with technology and also taken as challenge to manage and run the classes smoothly. Although effectiveness and satisfaction of both students

and teacher seems different as compare to physical classes, but to some extent, SDC has been able to manage its online classes smoothly.

7. Enrolment of students In 2076

Due to the pandemic of covid-19, academic calendar of Tribhuvan University is affected. SDC follows the guidance and instruction of TU. Regular academic activities such as enrolment of student, classes, assignments, exams, thesis proposal and Viva etc. are affected by this pandemic. But gradually these activities are resumed by TU as well as SDC also. Number of enrolment of students is fixed in special programme while no of enrolment of students is fluctuated in regular class. In semester system either odd semester classes or even semester class are run at once. Annual enrolment of BBS has increased in 2076 in comparison 2075.

10. Teaching pedagogy
